305 heliports, 3 FAA-approved pilot schools, 759 flight students

and 494 flight instructors; and

general aviation in Nebraska has an economic output of \$1.2 WHEREAS.

billion annually and supports 7,900 jobs; and

general aviation not only supports Nebraska's economy, it WHEREAS,

improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency medical and healthcare services, law-enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business travelers to their

destinations quickly and safely; and
