

A Proclamation by the Governor

WHEREAS, Nevada's general aviation industry contributes a significant amount of economic benefit to the State; and

WHEREAS, the annual economic impact of general aviation is \$721 million and general aviation contributes 3,384 jobs with an annual payroll of \$93 million; and

WHEREAS, the State of Nevada boasts 49 public use airports, 46 of those are general aviation only; home to 37 charter flight companies, 29 aircraft repair stations, 29 fixed-based operators, and multiple powered aircraft, gliders, helicopters and flight schools providing jobs; and

WHEREAS, the aviation industry plays a vital role in the lives of our citizens as well as in the operation of our businesses and agriculture; and

WHEREAS, business aviation is a critical tool for companies in Nevada to improve efficiency and increase productivity and reach rural areas, thereby bringing new business, investment and jobs to all areas of the State; and

WHEREAS, general aviation plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the continued vitality of aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions and aviation organizations is important to the growth of our economy; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important, public benefit, and direct, Congressional oversight is necessary to ensure stable funding of this system; and


WHEREAS, the general aviation industry will continue to play a vital role in the economy, emergency services and social well being of the State of Nevada; and
