*WHEREAS*, Nebraska is home to 81 public use airports, which serve 3,498 pilots and 2,013 active general aviation aircraft, and

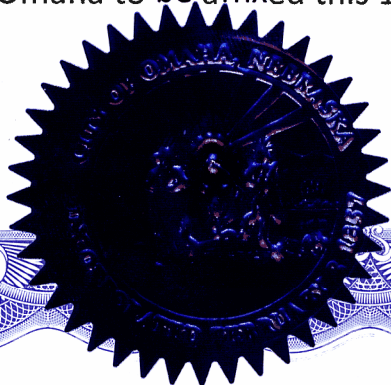
*WHEREAS*, General aviation in Nebraska has an economic output of \$1.2 billion annually, and supports 7,900 jobs, and
