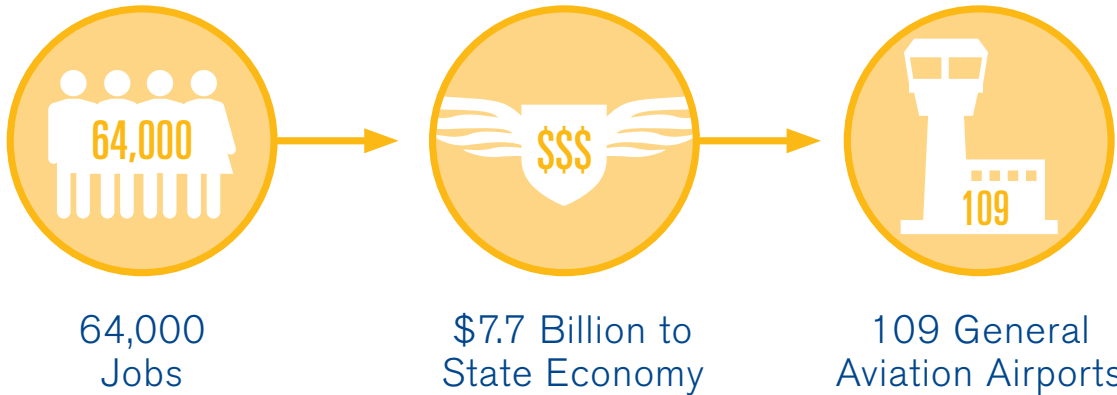


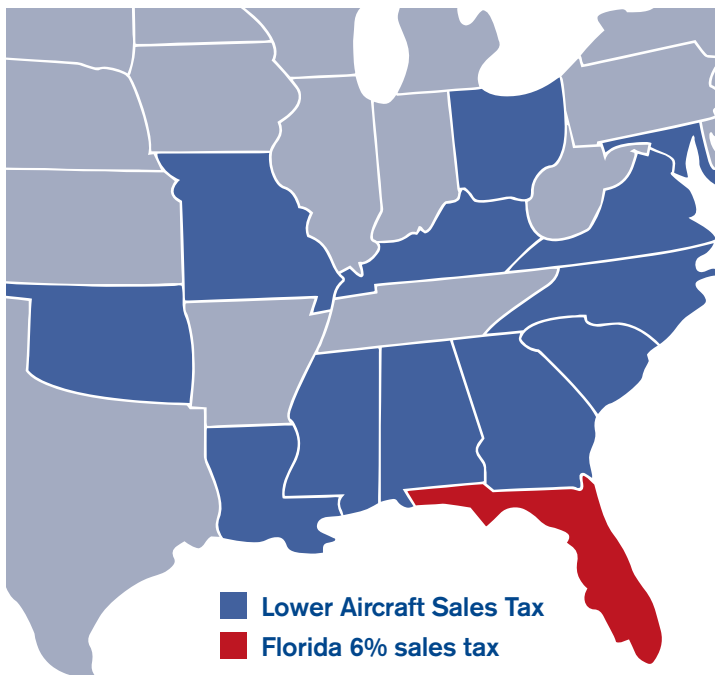
SUPPORT AVIATION TAX REFORM:

Make Florida Competitive with Surrounding States

GENERAL AVIATION IS CRITICAL TO FLORIDA'S ECONOMY



FLORIDA IS SURROUNDED BY STATES WITH LOWER AIRCRAFT SALES TAX



- **Senate Bill 580 reduces Florida aircraft sales and use tax rate from 6 to 4 percent**
- **Passage of the bill will make Florida more competitive – attracting new aviation jobs and investment**

AVIATION TAX REFORM GENERATES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- Massachusetts enacts Aircraft Sales Tax Exemption > Aircraft based in state increases 40%
- New York passes Aircraft Sales Tax Exemption > Business aircraft arrivals increase 38%
- Ohio enacts Aircraft Parts/Repair Exemption > Employment in air transportation sector grows by nearly 25%
