Re: AOA Lighting Circuit Work

As part of an ongoing project to replace the airfield lighting circuit cables Teterboro Airport will see a significant change in the scheduling of airport and runway closures.

Beginning May 11, 2019 work will start on replacing the cables that run from the airfield lighting vault to the circuit itself, known as the "home run." In order to ensure the safety of construction crews, all airfield lighting will need to be turned off necessitating early morning airport closures. This work will be conducted in segments, but will affect the entire airport surface throughout the completion of this project.

- These closures will only take place on the following days of work:
 - Saturday, Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday
- On days of work the following closure schedule will apply:
 - The airport will be closed from 0300L to 0600L
 - One runway will reopen at 0600L, and the remaining runway will stay closed until 1400L
 - Both runways will be available for use by 1400L
- Helicopter operations will be permitted during the scheduled airport closures.
- This work is expected to take six to eight months to complete.
- This work will be conducted in conjunction with other ongoing construction projects. Efforts will be made to consolidate work and mitigate impacts to aircraft operations.

During the early stages of this project, Runway 1/19 will be the runway remaining closed until 1400L to minimize the impact to departure operations as much as possible. Taxiway closures will also be associated with this work, and will be scheduled one week prior to their occurrence.

This work is weather dependent and subject to change. Aircraft operators are encouraged to check NOTAMs for the most up to date information.
