



**CMH Runway 10L/28R Rehabilitation
& Shoulder Improvements**

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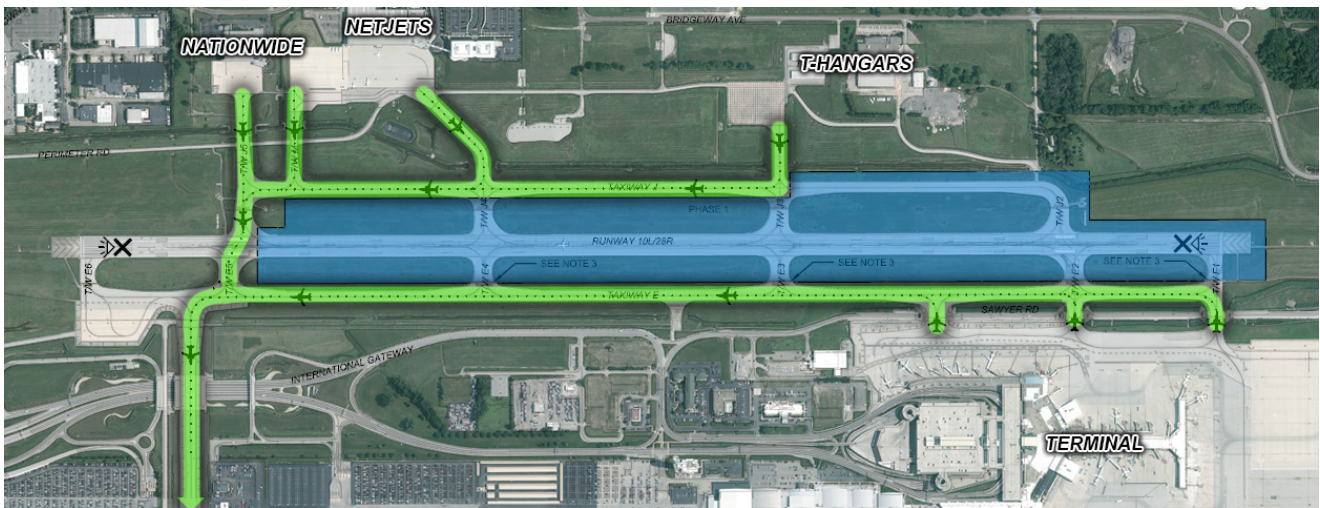
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Project Description

The project will rehabilitate Runway 10L/28R and the associated connector taxiways, as well as construct paved runway shoulders, realign several connector taxiways, and install LED lights and signage.

Upcoming Work

Construction is anticipated to begin the morning of Monday, April 4th and continue through mid-October. Runway 10L/28R will be closed during this time, with traffic on the north airfield being maintained to and from the south airfield. Work will begin immediately on Phase 1, the limits of which are shown below. Early construction activities will include pavement milling and construction of the new runway shoulders.



Upcoming Changes to the North Airfield

In order to prepare for the start of construction, Taxiways J2, J3 and J east of J3 will close the morning of Friday, April 1st to allow temporary pavement marking of Taxiway J3 to the GA Ramp. On Monday, April 4th Runway 10L/28R and the remaining associated connector taxiways, with the exception of Taxiways J5 and E5, will close for the duration of the project. Taxiways J5 and E5 will remain operational to maintain access for the tenants north of the runway. Taxiway E will remain operational to maintain access to the northern terminal gates.
