

# ACT NOW TO OPPOSE REPEAL OF NEW YORK AVIATION JOBS ACT

Please join the general aviation community in opposing New York State Senate Bill 7135 and Assembly Bill 9053 which would repeal the Aviation Jobs Act, leading to job losses and reduced economic growth.

Enacted as part of the 2015 budget, the Aviation Jobs Act makes New York competitive with surrounding states and has led to direct investment at airports across the state since its passage.
